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Camp Handbook

GENERAL INFORMATION

Camp Peace '11 is operated as part of the Children's Ministry of Peace United Methodist Church and is governed under the policies, practices, and supervision of that Ministry. We are licensed through the Florida Department of Children and Families and follow their guidelines. State License #C070R0188.

Please note that we are first and foremost a Church. We treat one another with respect and dignity. We will not allow our children, teachers, or staff to be exposed to foul or abusive language. Such actions are grounds for dismissal. We are happy to address, according to handbook guidelines, any concerns you may have as long as they are presented through the proper channels.

Camp Peace '11 will run three separate weeks and you may choose to attend 1, 2 or 3 sessions.

- Session 1 is June 13 to June 17.
- Session 2 is June 20 to June 24.
- Session 3 is June 27 to July 1.

Camp Peace '11 will be separated into 2 Camps as follows:

Elementary Camp is for completed Kindergarteners thru completed 5th Graders. This camp will run M-F, from 9am -1:30pm. Please read the Elementary Camp section of the Handbook for more information.

Pre-School Camp is for 4 yr olds who have previously attended a preschool/daycare and 5 yr olds who will attend Kindergarten in the fall of August 2011. This camp will run M-F, from 9am -1:30pm. Please read the Pre-School Camp section of the Handbook for more information.

GENERAL CAMP GUIDELINES AND POLICIES

The following are valid for all sessions of Camp Peace '11. Enrollment procedures and forms are detailed in the Enrollment section of the Registration Packet. Please read these carefully. You and your child will be expected to follow all of the Guidelines and Policies.

PAYMENT POLICY

- Registration fees are due at the time of registration and are non-refundable. Registration fees will be applied to your weekly camp fee. (see enrollment forms for more information)
- Weekly Camp Fees are due the first Monday of each Session (See specific Camp sections for

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details on fees).

- Any weekly payment received after 1:30pm on Monday will incur a \$15.00 late fee.
- If fees are not paid by 9:00am of the next camp day your child will not be admitted to camp.
- We accept payment by cash, check or money order only. There will be a \$20.00 fee for each check returned to us by your bank in addition to what your bank may charge. Payments thereafter must be made in cash.
- There will be no credit for sick or vacation days. If your child will be absent for any length of time, full weekly Camp fees must be paid to preserve their place. Please make arrangements to pay your Camp fees on time or in advance to avoid late charges.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP

- Camp starts at 9:00am. You may drop off your child starting at 8:45am. No child will be accepted earlier than 8:45am unless that child has been enrolled in the optional Early Drop-off (see below)
- Each child must be signed-in and signed-out every day by a responsible adult over the age of 18.
- For your child's safety, they will only be released to those listed in the Enrollment form or otherwise duly authorized by the parent/guardian to pick up your child.
- PLEASE PICK UP YOUR CHILD ON TIME. Each child will be charged \$5.00 per 5 minutes that he/she remains at the camp after pick up time. Late pick-up charges will be due the morning of the next camp day or your child will not be allowed to stay for camp.

OPTIONAL EARLY DROP-OFF AT 8:15AM.

- Early Drop-off MUST be reserved in advance. We cannot take your child without a 24-hour, written notice. You can reserve your spot on the Application that follows. The Camp Director may approve an exception to this in special circumstances.
- There is a \$10.00 fee per child, per week for Early Drop-off. This fee can be added to your weekly Camp fees and be paid on the Monday of the week of service.
- You may choose which weeks to use Early Drop-off.
- Early Drop-off is paid by the week even if the service is needed for less than 5 days. A week is defined as Monday through Friday.

HEALTH AND SICKNESS

- Children must have proof of Health Insurance to be enrolled. A copy of this information is to be given at enrollment.
- If your child is sick, please do not bring them to camp. Your child should not return until all contagious symptoms have passed and your child is ready to participate in the daily activities.

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This includes being fever free for 24 hrs. There is no credit for missed days. (See Health procedures)

- Camp Peace staff members or PUMC staff members will not administer medication of any kind.
- If your child gets sick while at camp, you will be expected to pick up your child or arrange their pick up within a reasonable amount of time after notification.
- Accidents and boo-boos happen. If this involves your child, we will use our best judgment to determine if the parent should be called. If your child receives a minor cut or scrape, we will clean it, apply a band-aid or ice, and give lots of love.
- We expect to have an emergency contact number at all times. If your contact information provided on the enrollment form changes, even for a day, please notify us at Sign-in.

SNACKS AND LUNCH

- The camp will provide one mid-morning snack. Please send in an appropriate snack if your child cannot have what we have planned for the day. (See Snacks section for details)
- **LUNCH IS NOT PROVIDED.** Parents are responsible to provide their child with a nutritious lunch including something to drink and utensils. Please send lunch in a labeled lunch bag. We cannot refrigerate lunches so please send something appropriate or include a freezer pack.
- If your child does not bring a lunch your account will be charged \$5.00 per lunch. Payment for the lunch must be made no later than the next scheduled weekly Camp Fee payment.
- Camp Peace '11 will strive to be a peanut-free facility. We ask that you speak to your child about the importance of not sharing their lunches. If your child has special dietary needs please note them in the health section of the enrollment form.

CLOTHING AND SHOES

- Please dress your child in attire that is appropriate for a Christian Summer Camp. No shirts will be allowed with inappropriate logos or advertisements, midriffs should be covered, shorts/dresses/skirts should be at fingertip length, etc. If this rule is violated, your child may be dismissed from our program.
- We plan to have as much fun as possible this summer! This includes the possibility of getting messy. Please dress your child for fun and save the “Sunday-Best” clothes and shoes for another time. We cannot be responsible for any lost, missing, or damaged clothing items or accessories.
- All children need to wear closed-toe shoes. If we schedule a water play day, please send appropriate swim shoes for your child to wear.

WHAT YOUR CHILD SHOULD BRING

- In addition to a daily lunch, please provide a bag/backpack for each child with its name on it.

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Include:

- A complete change of clothes including socks.
 - Sunscreen.
 - Sunglasses
 - Hat.
 - Swim-shoes (if we are planning a water day).
 - A towel. (If we are planning a water day).
 - Proper swim attire: one-piece swimsuit for girls. (If we are planning a water day).
- Please label all items brought to camp
 - Please do not allow children to bring in personal items such as toys, games, stuffed animals, blankets or any electronic device unless you have received notice from the Camp that these are acceptable. If your child carries a cell phone, we ask that you keep it for the time he/she is at camp. We are not responsible for any personal item brought to camp.

BEHAVIOR

- In our efforts to ensure Camp Peace '11 is safe and enjoyable for every child we will be strict with discipline and require every child to be responsible for his/her actions. **Discipline will always be firm and done in love using our best judgment, while keeping every child's best interest in mind.** (Please refer to the Discipline policy)
- Camp Peace '11 reserves the right to deny Camp to anyone and to have any child withdrawn from the Camp at any time, without prior notification.

WITHDRAWAL FROM CAMP

- A written notice is required to withdraw a child from summer camp. No credit/refunds will be given for days paid for after child is withdrawn. If you withdraw your child and then wish to re-enroll, full registration fees will be due.

Summer Camp can provide your child experiences and memories that will last forever. Your children are special to us. That's why we have designed our program especially for them! We will strive to raise self-esteem, create independence, foster creativity and imagination, and show them God's love while providing a positive and safe environment for all. With your prayers and support we can have great summer camp!

Please read on for specific information on each Summer Camp option.

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ELEMENTARY CAMP

The following information is specific for the Elementary Camp.
Please read the General Camp Guidelines as they also apply for Elementary Camp.

Age Range:

- Elementary Camp is for kids who have completed Kindergarten through completed 5th grade.

Elementary Camp will operate:

- 3 sessions
 - Session 1 is June 13 to June 17.
 - Session 2 is June 20 to June 24.
 - Session 3 is June 27 to July 1.
- 9:00am to 1:30pm.
- Monday through Friday.

Fee Schedule is as follows:

- Total camp fees this year are \$75.00 per child, per session. This will be paid in the following way:
 - \$25.00 is due at Registration per child, per session. This is non-refundable.
 - \$50.00 is due each Monday of camp, per child, per session.
 - \$10.00 Early Drop-off fees per child will be due each Monday of camp. (this is an extra fee)

Discounts:

- Camp Peace, '11 strives to be an efficient and affordable summer camp option. Because of this, we have already reduced our fees for this summer. No discounts will be offered this year.

Drop off time is 8:45am to 9:00am.

- Please escort your child to sign-in.

Optional Early Drop off time is 8:15am.

- There is a \$10.00 fee per child, per session for Early Drop-off. (See "Early Drop off" section in the General Camp Guidelines for more information)

Pick up time is 1:15pm to 1:30pm.

- PLEASE PICK UP YOUR CHILD NO LATER THAN 1:30PM. Each child will be charged \$5.00 for each 5 minutes that he/she remains at the camp after 1:30pm. Late pick-up charges will be due the morning of the next camp day or the child will not be allowed to stay for camp.

Please read the General Camp Guidelines found on page 5 for more information and for what your child needs to bring to camp.

PRE-SCHOOL CAMP

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The following information is specific for the Pre-School Camp.
Please read the General Camp Guidelines as they also apply for Pre-School Camp.

Age Range:

- Pre-School Camp is for kids who are:
 - 4 years old by June 1st and have previously attended a daycare or pre-school.
 - 5 years old and going into Kindergarten in the fall of 2011.
 - Fully potty-trained.

Pre-School Camp will operate:

- 3 sessions
 - Session 1 is June 13 to June 17.
 - Session 2 is June 20 to June 24.
 - Session 3 is June 27 to July 1.
- 9:00am to 1:30pm.
- Monday through Friday.

Fee Schedule is as follows:

- Total camp fees this year are \$75.00 per child, per session. This will be paid in the following way:
 - \$25.00 is due at Registration per child, per session. This is non-refundable.
 - \$50.00 is due each Monday of camp, per child, per session.
 - \$10.00 Early Drop-off fees per child will be due each Monday of camp. (this is an extra fee)

Discounts:

- Camp Peace, '11 strives to be an efficient and affordable summer camp option. Because of this, we have already reduced our fees for this summer. No discounts will be offered this year.

Drop off time is 8:45am to 9:00am.

- Please escort your child to sign-in.

Optional Early Drop off time is 8:15am.

- There is a \$10.00 fee per child, per session for Early Drop-off. (See "Early Drop off" section in the General Camp Guidelines for more information)

Pick up time is 1:15pm to 1:30pm.

- PLEASE PICK UP YOUR CHILD NO LATER THAN 1:30PM. Each child will be charged \$5.00 for each 5 minutes that he/she remains at the camp after 1:30pm. Late pick-up charges will be due the morning of the next camp day or the child will not be allowed to stay for camp.

Please read the General Camp Guidelines found on page 5 for more information and for what your child needs to bring to camp.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

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We view discipline as guidance, not punishment. We are dedicated to helping children develop inner discipline by providing reasonable rules and logical consequences for breaking rules. Discipline strategies we use are positive reinforcement, active listening, and redirection. A child may be given a period of “time-out” from the group if he or she continually demonstrates unacceptable behavior.

“Time-out” is not a punishment, but a time when the child can calm down, remember the behavior the teacher expects, and decides when he or she will rejoin the group with appropriate behavior.

The Teacher will notify the Director of Summer Camp or Supervisor in charge if a problem occurs. Corporal punishment will not be used. Children will not be hit, slapped or spanked. No child will be humiliated, shamed, frightened or verbally abused. Food cannot and will not be used as a form of discipline. This is in accordance with the Florida Department of Children and Families.

If a behavior problem persists, the parents will be asked to attend a conference to discuss possible techniques for motivating the child to behave in an acceptable way. If, after repeated attempts and parental involvement the problem still persists, the child may be dismissed from the Camp the rest of the summer.

HEALTH AND SAFETY PROCEDURES

If your child becomes ill or is injured at church, we will contact you. If we cannot reach you, we will isolate and care for your child until you arrive for pick-up. Please be sure to update your Emergency contact information as it changes.

Please keep your child home if he/she:

1. Has a fever of 100 degrees or more.
2. Has had a fever during the previous 24 hours.
3. Has a cold that is less than three days old.
4. Has an unidentified rash.
5. Is fussy, cranky, and generally irritable.
6. Had an upset stomach and /or diarrhea within the last 24 hours.
7. Has any contagious condition or symptoms or such condition.

Please notify the Director of Summer Camp, the Supervisor in charge, or the Director of Children’s Ministries of PUMC immediately if your child has a communicable disease.

Your child may attend camp if 1) the cold is over and minor nasal discharge remains, 2) there has been an exposure to a communicable disease but the proper person at Camp has been notified and incubation dates discussed, 3) your child has been on an antibiotic for 24 hours and has been cleared by your physician.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY/INJURY

If your child is injured while participating in Camp Peace ‘11 we will practice the following procedures. If the injury is a minor cut or scrape, the wound will be cleaned with soap and water and a Band-aid will be applied. Ice will be applied when necessary. An accident report will be filled out which will require your signature stating that you have been informed of the situation. In the case of a more serious injury, we will locate or contact you immediately and inform you of the situation. An ambulance will be called if necessary. Please be sure to keep all records up to date.

GENERAL INFORMATION

WE CANNOT ASSIGN YOUR CHILD TO A CAMP SLOT UNTIL ALL THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS, REGISTRATION/SUPPLY FEES, AND FORMS IN THIS PACKET ARE PROPERLY AND COMPLETELY FILLED OUT.

- Drop off completed forms, fees, and documents at the Church Office M-F, 8:30am to 3:30pm. Or you may mail it to Peace United Methodist Church, 13502 Town Loop Blvd., Orlando, FL 32837, Attn: Camp Peace '11.
- Space is limited and children will be accepted on a **first-come, first-served basis**. We will process Applications in the order in which they are received.
- **You will receive a letter or email Confirming Enrollment.** Letters will be mailed to the main address on your Enrollment Application. Emails will be sent to the email address provided. Letters will be sent out no later than 10 days after we receive your complete information.
- If we reach capacity and your child cannot be placed, we will attempt to contact you 2 times by phone at the numbers you provide. You may choose to place your child on our waiting list or to pick up your personal information and fees. We cannot guarantee enrollment of kids on our waiting list.
- If we are missing information, we will attempt to contact you 2 times by phone at the numbers you provide on the enrollment form. Your child will not be enrolled until the missing information is provided.
- If your child is not enrolled due to space limitations or missing information, all personal information, forms, and fees will be returned to you AFTER the first week of camp has started.
